





Indonesia's ban on NI and BAUXITE




Indonesia's government still allows exports of copper, iron ore, lead, and zinc, no relief is offered to nickel and bauxite.

Supply side got worsened, too..





China's Nickel Ore story


China Nickel Ore Imports







Global Coal Consumption.....Here to Stay






Future Developments


